What are Neurodevelopmental Disorders?

The *Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, 5th Edition: DSM-5* defines Neurodevelopmental disorders as "a group of conditions with onset in the developmental period. The disorders typically manifest early in development, often before the child enters grade school, and are characterized by developmental deficits that produce impairments of personal, social, academic, or occupational functioning"

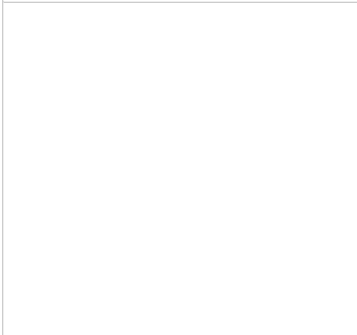
